How the Virtual Modules Work Behind the Scenes

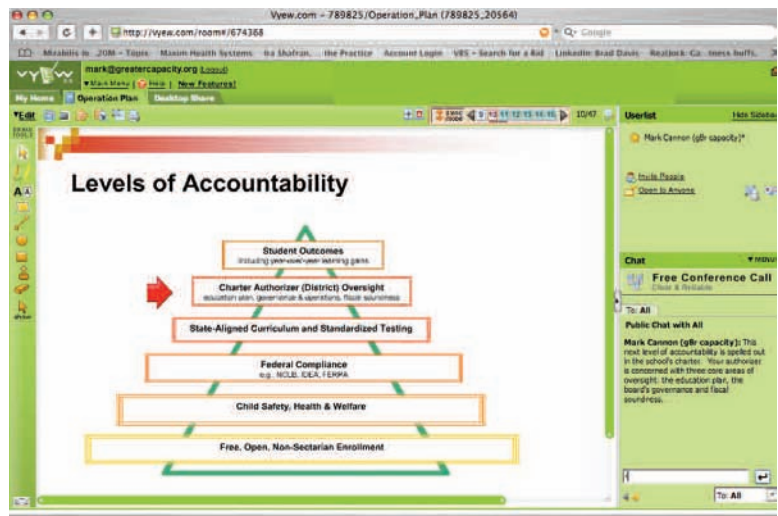
